## **QUICK START GUIDE**

### **Lawn Mowers**

This guide is meant to serve as a quick reference for operating your Hyundai Lawn Mower.

It is for convenience and not intended to replace the information found in the product manual provided. Use outdoors only.

Petrol Lawn Mowers produce carbon monoxide — a poisonous, colourless & odourless gas that can cause death or serious injury. Petrol is highly flammable, always handle with extreme care and in a well ventilated area.

Always remove HT lead from spark plug when checking machine or changing parts.



Do not attempt to lift the lawn mower out of the box on your own, instead seek assistance or cut each corner of the box and lay the sides flat. At this point, check that you have all of the included items listed above. If any are missing or damaged, call 01646 687 880 or email info@hyundaipowerequipment.co.uk. ASSEMBLY:







#### **Catcher Assembly**

Insert the metal frame into grass bag [40P, 43P, 43SP Only] (1) and lift the rear cover (2). Clip the grass catcher onto the rear of the mower at this point (3).







Handle Assembly: Attach the handle onto the base unit using the supplied bolts [(4) All models (5) 40P only]. If upper handles are attached unfold and then lock in place using the fixed clamps (6). If upper handle is not attached fix in place using the supplied bolts (7).

Take care to ensure the cables are not snagged or stretched.







Height Adjustment: [40P Only] Each wheel can be adjusted manually to one of three settings (8). Choose the desired height and set each wheel to the same level (9). Attach all of the wheels (10).







#### **Height Adjustment:**

[All Other Models] Pull the adjustment lever outwards (11) and select the required height (12). This height is automatically adjusted for all wheels.

Pull Start Handle: [All Models] Slowly pull the recoil cord until it reaches the recoil retaining loop on the right hand handle and thread it through the loop (13).

Electric Start Module: [46SPE and 51SPE Only] Take the plastic panel and remove the highlighted section (14). Align the mounting holes on the plastic panel with the mounting holes on the upper handle, then fit the plastic panel on with the provided nuts and bolts (15). Connect the engine cable (16) and battery (17). To charge, use the charge socket for 6 hours before use.



Mulching Plug [46SP, 46SPE, 51SP and 51SPE Only] Lift the rear cover and remove the grass catcher (18). Push the mulching wedge into the discharge channel and lock it into the slot (19). Lower the rear cover (20).

#### **Cut And Drop / Side Discharge**

[46SP, 46SPE, 51SP and 51SPE Only] Do as in step 19 & 20 and then lift the side flap for side discharge (21). Mount the discharge chute for side discharge on the support pin of the side flap (22). Lower the side flap so it lies on top of the side discharge chute (23).







#### **Adding Oil:**

Remove the oil dipstick (24) and add SAE 15W-40 oil to the upper mark on the dipstick (25). Do not overfill. Refit the dipstick (26).







#### **Adding Petrol:**

Remove the fuel tank cap (27) and fill it with unleaded petrol 25mm from top of tank (28). Refit the tank cap (29).







#### Starting Procedure:

Push throttle lever all the way forward.(30). [All models except electric start]
Pump primer bulb 5 times (31). Ensure the blade is free turning [free of long grass and with cutting height set to maximum] (32).

Pull back the Operator Presence Control (OPC) lever towards main handle (33) and pull recoil start handle swiftly (34) or use key start on electric start models- maximum 5 seconds at a time. Repeat until engine starts.

On Electric start models, when engine has started, pull throttle lever back approx. 25mm/1 inch to 'run' position (35) (fully forward is in choke position).
